He co-chaired the US-UK Financial Regulatory Working Group and the US-EU Joint Regulatory Forum, and led Treasury’s work on the G20 Sustainable Finance Working Group. Swinehart also chaired the G7 and FSB work on cross-border data flows in financial services.

Swinehart was earlier Senior Counsel for International Trade and Financial Regulatory Policy, serving as chief legal advisor to the Secretary on trade and international financial regulation and leading negotiations on financial services, currency, and exchange rate matters.

Swinehart received a J.D. from the University of Texas School of Law and a B.S. in Civil Engineering and a B.A. in Environmental Engineering from Rice University.
